⁷ **Preschool Teachers, Except Special Education** (SOC 25-2011) "Instruct children (normally up to 5 years of age) in activities designed to promote social, physical, and intellectual growth needed for primary school in preschool, day care center, or other child development facility."

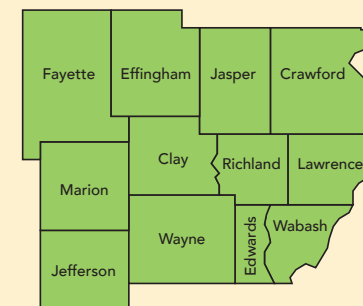

The median annual salaries of all child care providers in this report are significantly below the median earnings of persons living and working in each county.¹ While individuals serving in administrative capacities in child care centers are most likely to receive wages barely above the county's median wage (between \$28,964 and \$34,652 for administrative directors and director/teachers), the majority of child care center teachers (\$24,960) and assistant teachers (\$20,800) are earning well below the median wage for employed persons in their county with family child care providers (\$20,800²) and child care center assistant teachers (\$20,800) earning the least. When it comes to insurance and pension benefits, about one in five child care center staff members are provided partial or full coverage by their employer.

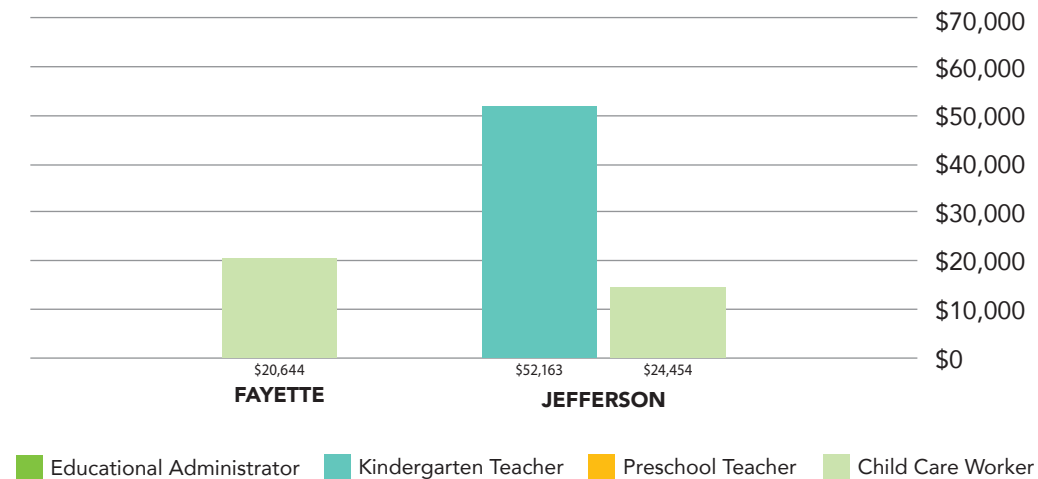
CHILD CARE STAFF RECEIVING BENEFITS / 2021



The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) reported median yearly wages for 2020 for four early care and education occupations (Educational Administrators of Preschools/Child Care Programs⁵, Kindergarten Teachers⁶, Preschool Teachers⁷, and Child Care Workers⁸) in four of the twelve counties in this report – Effingham, Fayette, Jefferson, and Marion.

Although the specific occupational definitions differed from IDES descriptions and the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey* descriptions, salaries were rather consistent with one another in that wages within IDES's preschool teacher and child care worker categories and the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey* child care staff categories were within the same range; however, it should be noted that the IDES's definition of child care worker includes a provider working in either a center or family child care home which is differentiated by the *Illinois Salary & Staffing Survey*.

KEY POINTS FROM THE ILLINOIS SALARY & STAFFING SURVEY OF LICENSED CHILD CARE FACILITIES: FY 2021

The median full-time, full-year salary of child care staff range from \$20,800 for assistant teachers to \$34,652 for administrative directors.

Teachers, 66.2% of whom have an associate's degree or higher, have a median annual salary of approximately \$22,360.

Nearly half (45.5%) of family child care practitioners net \$10,000 or less annually.
